CONFIDENTIAL SHREDDING SERVICE

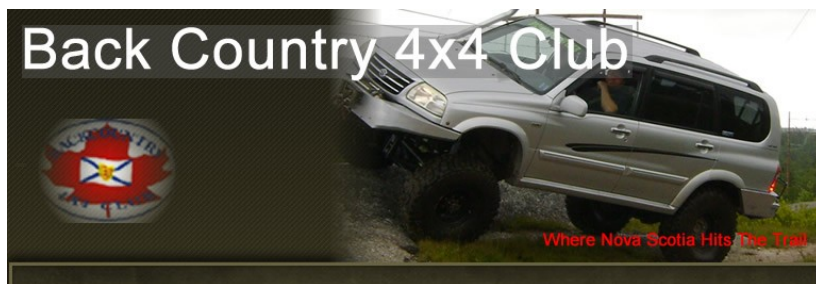
We have two industrial shredders donated to us by the United Way of Lunenburg County. Our staff and participants are very efficient in handling large contracts and would appreciate
